Each route begins and ends with a public transport link. For details see beenetwork.com

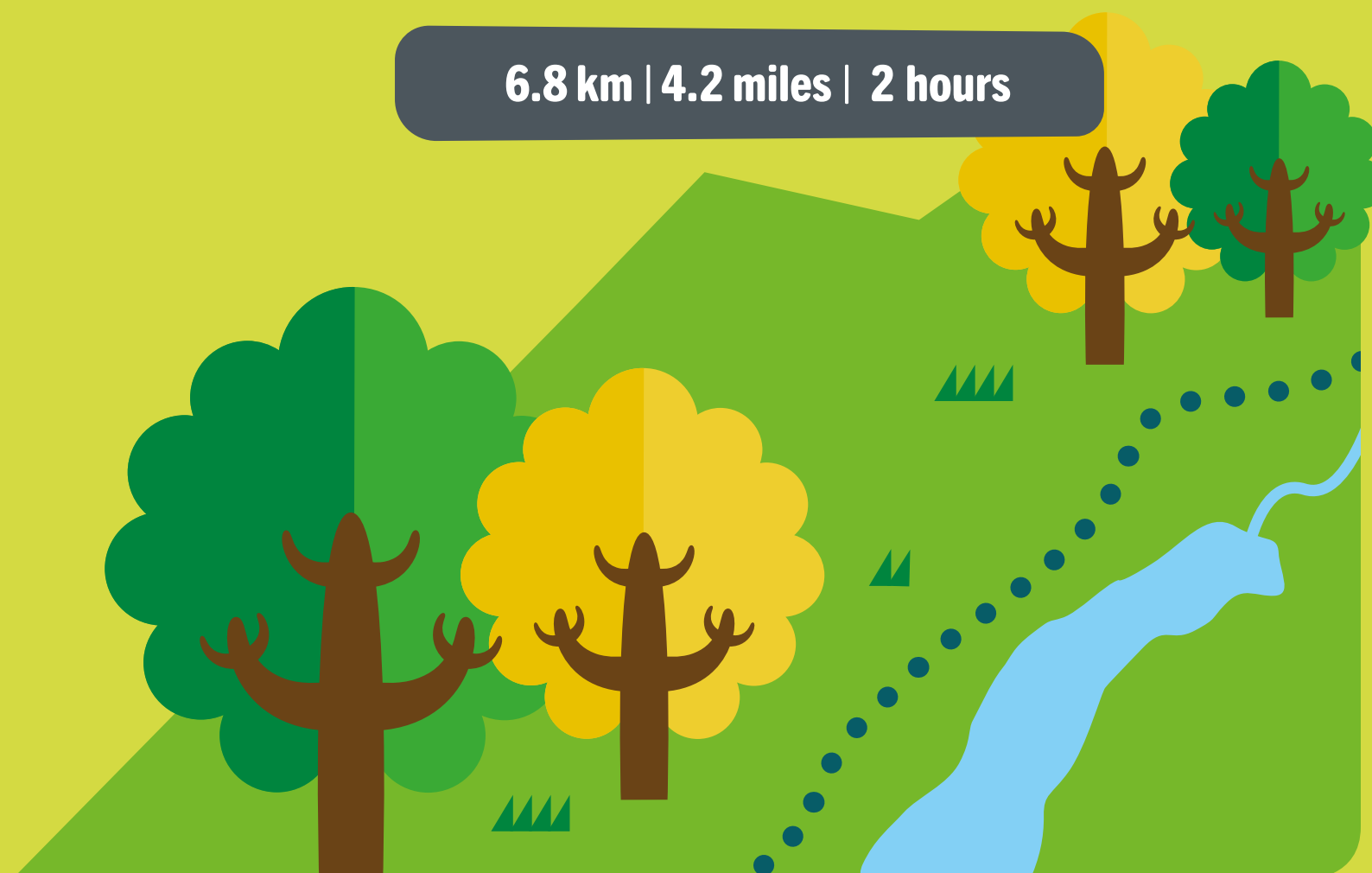

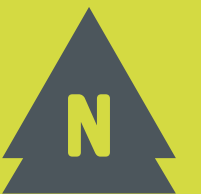
- 1 Chapel Street Park to Delamere Park

- 6 Queens Park to Mayfield Park and Ardwick Green
- 7 Ardwick Green to Whitworth Park
- 8 Whitworth Park to Alexandra Park Café
- 9 Alexandra Park Café to Chorlton Bus Station
- 10 Chorlton Bus Station to Southern Cemetery
- 11 Barlow Moor Road to Martinscroft Metrolink
- 12 **Martinscroft Metrolink to Peel Hall Metrolink**
- 13 Peel Hall Metrolink to Northenden Riverside Park
- 14 Northenden Riverside Park to Fletcher Moss Park
- 15 Fletcher Moss Park to Chapel Street Park

Cross from Metrolink stop
to Martinscroft Road and go
straight ahead to Firbank Road.

At Portway, cross and
turn right for 10m to reach a
footpath to Threapwood Road.
Do not go along Ashmoor Walk.

9

Leaving Tayfield Park, cross Portway and
follow the path to Dinmoor Road. Turn left
coming out at Culmere Road. Enter
Culmere Park and leave at the far end.
Turn right then left onto Austell Road.

Turn left up Selstead Road to Woodhouse Park
Lifestyle Centre. Turn right onto Portway then
left up Gritley Walk. Turn right onto Tayfield
Road and enter Tayfield Park.

Before reaching the
stream, turn a sharp left
(almost a U-turn) and
climb the steps up the
embankment. Follow the
path to Falkirk Walk and
cross the motorway.

5

Cross Greenbrow Road
and go to the end of
Crowland Road. Go
through the gate and
then straight ahead
towards the stream
(though it may be
dried up).

3

Enter Milky Button Park
and follow the stream to
the 2nd bridge. Cross
stream and turn right to
reach Tuffley Road.

2

At the end of Alderman
Rodgers Park, go through
the gate, cross the road and
take the footpath opposite.
Follow path to Whitburn Road.

4

Cross over Tuffley Road
and follow the path at
the back of the houses.
Where the path forks,
take a left to the
Tree of Life Centre.

7

Follow Bleasdale Road and
Maismore Road to Porton Walk
and enter Painswick Park. Follow
the fence around to the left to
reach a pond. Go around the
pond and take the path to the
left, by the childrens playground.
