Each route begins and ends with a public transport link. For details see beenetwork.com

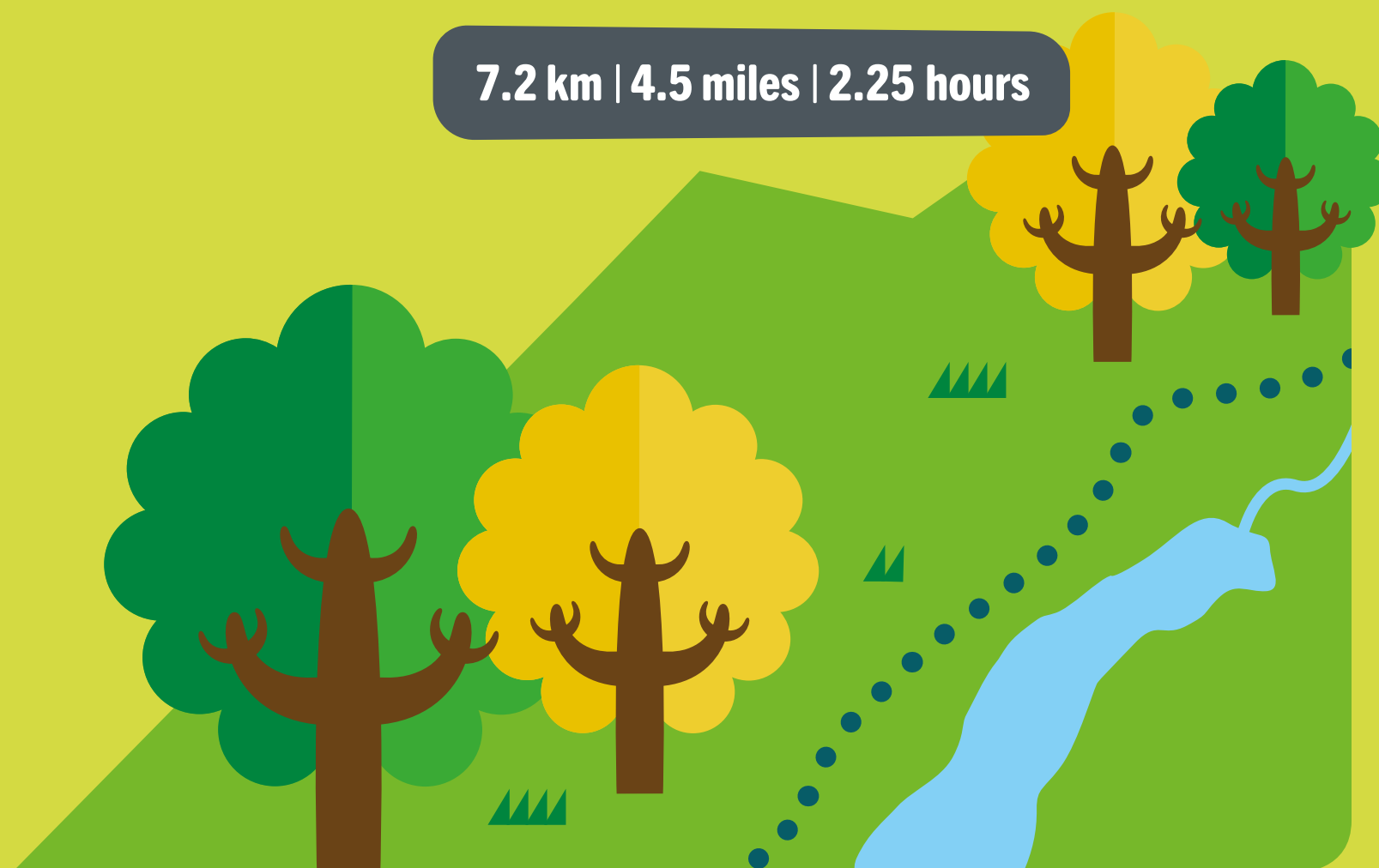
MANCHESTER GREEN TRAIL

- 1 Chapel Street Park to Delamere Park
- 2 Delamere Park to Central Park Metrolink
- 3 **Central Park Metrolink to Boggart Hole Clough**
- 4 Boggart Hole Clough to Heaton Park Metrolink
- 5 Heaton Park Metrolink to Queens Park
- 6 Queens Park to Mayfield Park and Ardwick Green
- 7 Ardwick Green to Whitworth Park
- 8 Whitworth Park to Alexandra Park Café
- 9 Alexandra Park Café to Chorlton Bus Station
- 10 Chorlton Bus Station to Southern Cemetery
- 11 Barlow Moor Road to Martinscroft Metrolink
- 12 Martinscroft Metrolink to Peel Hall Metrolink
- 13 Peel Hall Metrolink to Northenden Riverside Park
- 14 Northenden Riverside Park to Fletcher Moss Park
- 15 Fletcher Moss Park to Chapel Street Park



A mix of urban and park walking, this route includes Moston Vale, Broadhurst Park and ending up following any of the diverse routes through Boggart Hole Clough to Rochdale Road.

Follow the path until it swings right and emerges onto Lightbowne Road, just past the cemetery. Cross here and go straight on to reach Moston Lane. Cross and go right then left down Horncastle Road to enter Boggart Hole Clough. Go left alongside the fence and carry on to the Boating Lake and cafe. Bear left and continue on this path to exit the park onto Rochdale Road.

From Central Park Metrolink stop walk up The Gateway and turn right onto Northampton Road. Look for a public footpath sign ahead on the left, leading to Moston Vale. Enter and follow the path which goes to the end of the Vale and loops back. Exit at a public footpath sign and cross Church Lane taking the path opposite which swings right to Lightbourne Road.

Cross Lightbowne Road and walk across open space to Hugo Street. Follow to end of cul-de-sac and go past some houses turning left behind them, to the end of Egbert Street. Go right here, through a grassy area to reach Joyce Street, turn right and then go left along St. Mary's Road.
