- 1 Chapel Street Park to Delamere Park
- 2 Delamere Park to Central Park Metrolink
- 3 Central Park Metrolink to Boggart Hole Clough
- 4 **Boggart Hole Clough to Heaton Park Metrolink**
- 5 Heaton Park Metrolink to Queens Park
- 6 Queens Park to Mayfield Park and Ardwick Green
- 7 Ardwick Green to Whitworth Park
- 8 Whitworth Park to Alexandra Park Café
- 9 Alexandra Park Café to Chorlton Bus Station
- 10 Chorlton Bus Station to Southern Cemetery
- 11 Barlow Moor Road to Martinscroft Metrolink
- 12 Martinscroft Metrolink to Peel Hall Metrolink
- 13 Peel Hall Metrolink to Northenden Riverside Park
- 14 Northenden Riverside Park to Fletcher Moss Park
- 15 Fletcher Moss Park to Chapel Street Park



A pleasant walk through parks starting at Boggart Hole Clough and finishing at Heaton Park. On the way the walk passes through several smaller urban parks and Blackley Cemetery.

Turn right, then left onto Kerr Street and right onto Hill Lane. Enter Plant Hill Park on your left via Laurel Bank Gardens. Walk through the park ahead, keep to the left path past a notice board, and walk down to French Barn Lane. Turn right here and walk to Tweedle Common at Plant Hill Road.

Enter Heaton Park via Victoria Avenue and Middleton Road. Follow route through Heaton Park to the Metrolink stop on Bury Old Road.

Do not walk to the top, turn left and go down, walking around the wooded area through Dam Head Park. Turn left at the fence and walk down towards Rochdale Road.

Enter the Common ahead and turn left following the path round. Do not leave this main path but follow it round right until you get to the gate at Tweedle Hill Road. Cross ahead here and enter another green area exiting at Poolton Road. Turn right and left at the top along Crab Lane. Turn right onto Chapel Lane and enter Blackley Cemetery and Crematorium.

Walk through the Cemetery turning left at Oak Walk and exit at the main gates, turning left onto Victoria Avenue.

Enter Boggart Hole Clough through the main gate and walk down to the junction of paths at the bridge. Turn left and take the right path uphill (Oliver Clough). At the top turn left at the Visitors Centre (Sports Centre on right). Cross Charlestown Road and enter Bailey's Wood on the left by the public footpath sign.
